Two Days of Fruitful Discussion on Digital Services in Ljubljana

Podgorica – The 2nd SEE Digi.TV Conference gathered more than 90 participants from the South-East European regulatory authorities, television and electronic communications industry, international organisations, academia and civil society in Ljubljana on the 18th and 19th of October 2012. The event was organised by APEK, the Post and Electronic Communications Agency of the Republic of Slovenia, in close cooperation with the project partners, including partners from Montenegro (Agency for Electronic Media and Agency for Electronic Communications and Postal Services).

The conference was opened by the Director General of APEK, Mr Franc Dolenc, the National Coordinator for European Transnational Territorial Cooperation Programmes and SEE Programme Monitoring Committee Member, Ms Margarita Jančič, and the SEE Digi.TV Project Manager, Ms Tanja Kerševan Smokvina.

The topics of four panels complemented each other in a way to provide a comprehensive and integrated picture of most important issues, currently dealt with within the project. The discussants on societal aspects of digital divide in the South East Europe and possible measures to tackle it; position of broadcasters and telecom operators with regard to digital dividend and ways of awarding it for the public benefit; future of terrestrial broadcasting, and regional specifics and business strategies of other digital platforms were selected among the most representative stakeholders in the region and among the renowned international experts.
